## Bridgton Art Guild Art Scholarship

The Bridgton Art Guild (B.A.G.) is a non-profit organization, founded by artists to foster visual arts in the Lakes Region. We run a cooperative art gallery, Gallery 302, in Bridgton, Maine.

We are pleased to announce that we will be awarding a \$500.00 scholarship to a talented senior student who has been accepted by a college or university and plans to pursue an advanced education in art. This award will be presented directly to the school **after** the student has submitted to the B.A.G. Scholarship Committee proof of having successfully completed the first semester. The funds will be earmarked for supplies and/or books.

This scholarship will be granted on the basis of ability and potential. The B.A.G. Scholarship Committee will review applications and select the individual recipient for the award. Applications are to be submitted by **May 1 st.** 

Applicants must include the following:

- 1. Bridgton Art Guild application form
- 2. A cover letter to introduce yourself to the committee, telling us:
  - a. Why you feel you deserve this financial opportunity
  - b. What you are doing with your interest in art beyond the classroom
  - c. What is important to you about your work.
- 3. Two letters of recommendation one each from your guidance counselor or equivalent and your art teacher or mentor.
- 4. A portfolio of your most recent art work. We suggest you include 3 of your best examples of drawing, painting, design, or 3 dimensional work. Submissions may be in either color photo or scanned print (digital) format. These submissions will not be returned to the applicant! Art work must be labeled with: artist's name, dimensions, medium, and date of completion.
- 5. A brief (200 word) statement answering the question:

Why is art important in your life?

Recipients and parents or guardians will be notified by registered mail of the awards. It is the responsibility of the student to submit an official transcript at the end of the first semester. Any recipient who fails to notify B.A.G. within six (6) weeks of completing the first semester will forfeit the scholarship award. Please keep this letter for future reference.
